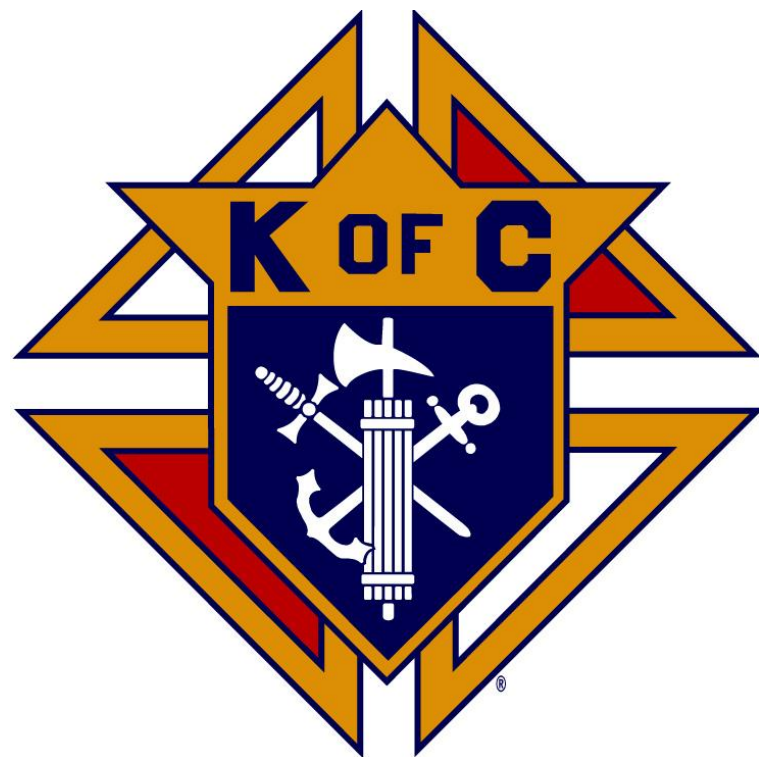

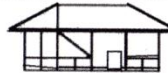

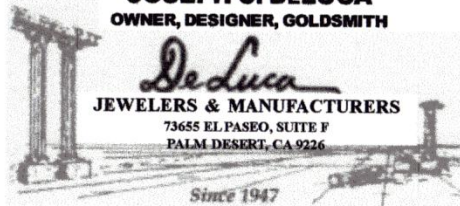

Pro-Life Report

NFP: Not Just Good, but Good for You

Most NFP couples know that Natural Family Planning offers many benefits to women's physical health, but it's also good for you emotionally, relationally and spiritually.

Emotional Health - An obvious way NFP benefits a woman's emotional health is by giving her the tools to anticipate days when she might be more sensitive to stress because of hormonal changes. A woman can feel more successful and accomplish more when she is feeling her best. She can also anticipate times when she might need more quiet, order or peace, so she can plan activities for the kids that are easier to manage. NFP also helps to know the difference between depression and normal Phase III blues.

Relational Health - There are two ways that NFP can facilitate relational health. When a husband knows his wife's signs, he can anticipate those times when she might need more emotional support. This can lead to fewer arguments, and contribute to better marital rapport. Couples also benefit from the increased communication that results from NFP.

Spiritual Health - NFP couples benefit spiritually from the graces they receive from faithfully living out the Catholic vision of love, but they also are more aware of the need to pray together. They can take the information they are getting from their charting to prayer so that they may more perfectly discern God's will for their lives. Bringing every aspect of our lives to God in joyful surrender allows couples to experience the infusion of grace and love.

- The children and grandchildren of dues paying (or honorary and honorary life members) of Council 3744 are eligible to participate even if they do not live in the area, belong to the local parishes or attend an area school provided they fulfill the rest of the qualifications.

Applications for scholarships are available on the "Scholarship" page of the website. Please download all documents needed. The deadline for submission of applications is **Saturday, May 4, 2013**.

As Scholarship Chairman, it is my responsibility to provide the opportunity to apply for one of the ten \$1,000 scholarships we award, arrange for the judges and distribute the completed scholarship application packages to the judges.
