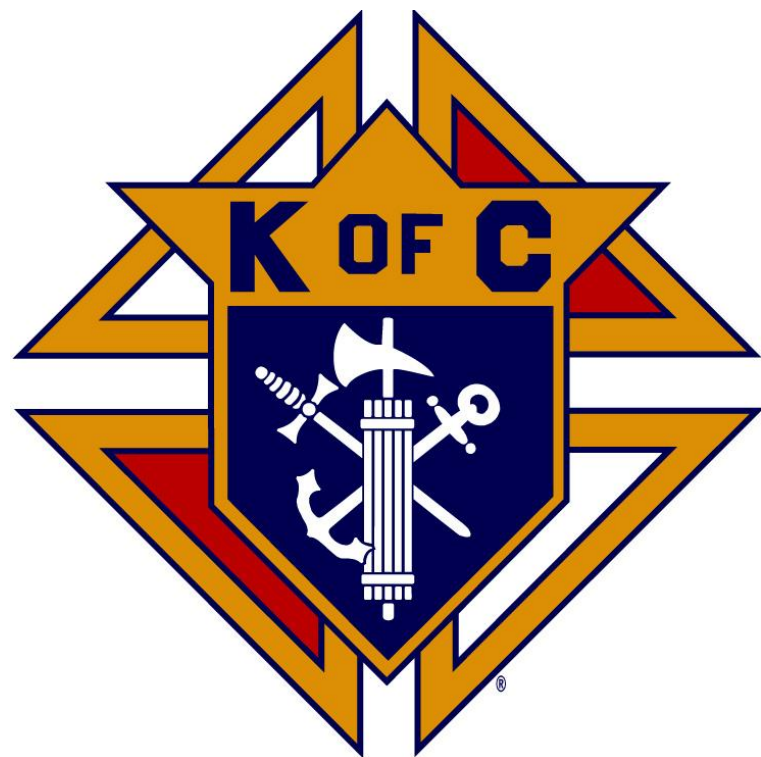

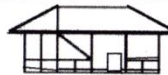

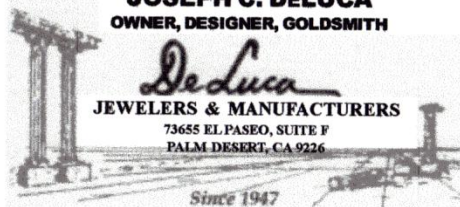

Media Violence an Influence?

In the wake of killings at schools and elsewhere, our nation is paying closer attention to the effects of media violence on children [and others]. According to a doctor's testimony given in Congress in 2003, "... the correlation between violent media and aggressive behavior in children is stronger than that of calcium intake and bone mass, lead ingestion and IQ ... tobacco smoke and lung cancer, all associations that clinicians accept as fact." In 2008, the FCC agreed, in a report that said that violent TV harmed children, and could - and should - be regulated. Yet, nothing happened! Shows such as The Following, Twisted, Hannibal, and violent shows Ripper Street, Cult and Bates Motel draw viewers into a fascination for killers.

To combat this situation, we can:

- Hold corporate advertisers accountable
- Hold Hollywood accountable in the public sphere
- Strengthen the V-Chip ratings

It takes an effort from all the public.

Father Kapaun receives posthumous Medal of Honor

Father Emil J. Kapaun, Chaplain, US Army, a native of Pilsen, Kansas, and accredited by the Diocese of Wichita, United States of America, was Chaplain of the 8th Cavalry Regiment, 1st Cavalry Division, Korea, in 1950.

Chaplain Kapaun distinguished himself, as both a Soldier and a Chaplain, on the field of battle in Korea during the early days of the Korean War in an uncommon manner, ministering both spiritually and physically to his fellow Soldiers.

Chaplain Kapaun while a prisoner of war in several camps in the vicinity of PYOKTONG, NORTH KOREA, unselfishly gave himself in total service to his fellow Prisoners of War, his military duty and his commitment as an instrument of God, to provide aid and comfort to his fellow Prisoners of War . Chaplain Kapaun died on May 23, 1951.

Chaplain Kapaun through the example of his life and military duty has become one of the most popular heroes of the Korean War, Soldier and Saint, an inspiration to his fellow prisoners, and all who serve in the military, who gave of himself until he was spent, often referred to as the man who best sums up the glory of the Chaplain Corps, and was universally known as a "soldier's soldier" and a saint by those who served with him during his military service, and especially by those who suffered with him in the brutal Communist prison camps of North Korea.

Father Kapaun cause for canonization formally opened in 2008 in his hometown of Pilsen, Kansas. Church officials in Kansas and elsewhere have collected documentation to support the sainthood cause and continue to advocate for the priest's canonization. Several priests of the Archdiocese of St. Louis who were classmates of Father Kapaun had been advocates in promoting his sainthood cause.

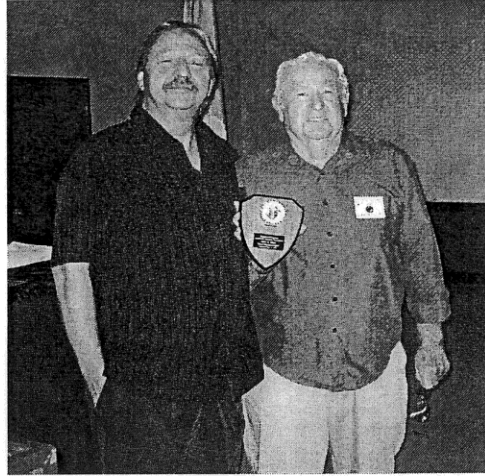
Father Emil Kapaun, whose actions as a U.S. Army chaplain during the Korean War and in a North Korean prisoner of war camp before his death, was awarded the Medal of Honor by President Barack Obama at the White House April 11, 2013, Helen Kapaun, and her family were on hand to receive the medal.

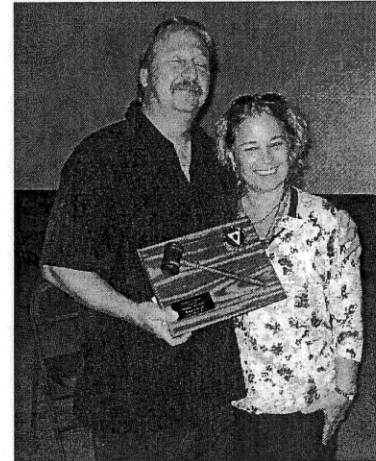
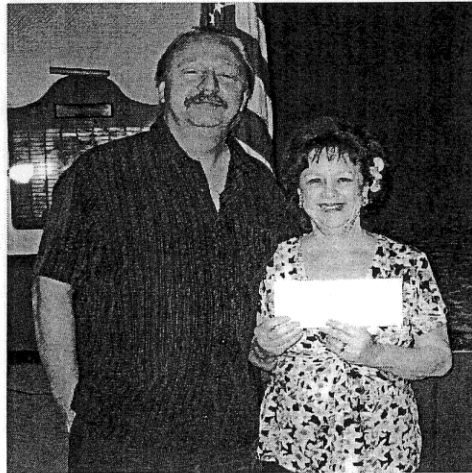
