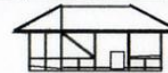

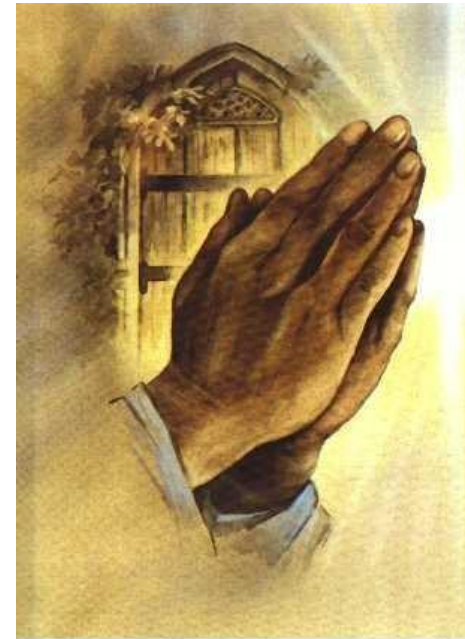

the service at 2:45 pm.

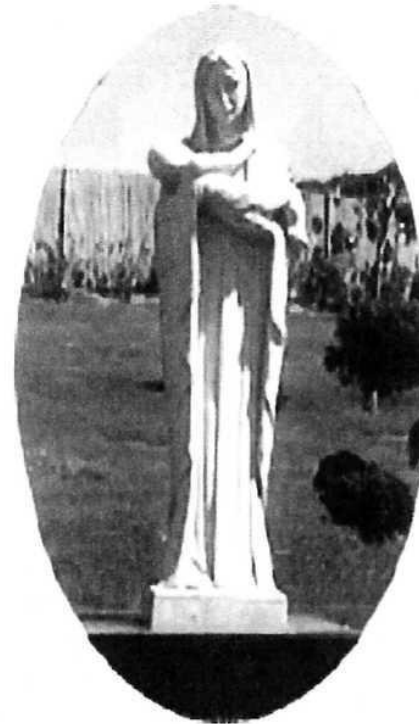

Insurance

Only having "through work" insurance can be a bit scary.
