

Las Vegas Night Returns to Visitation




Sat Nov 9 from 6:30pm - Midnight

Decency Report - Homosexuality

The Catholic Church is careful to distinguish three things when speaking about homosexuality: the person, the action, and the inclination. The person always has value by their creation in the image and likeness of God, redeemed by Christ, and an heir to grace. The action is not consistent with the identity of the person, thus "intrinsically disordered," at grave variance with the good of the person. Because homosexual actions thwart the procreative power of the sexual faculty and "do not proceed from a genuine affective and sexual complementarity," they can never be approved. Finally, the inclination is "objectively disordered," which means that such desires are misdirected or out of harmony with man's identity or being as given him by his creator "from the beginning." They cannot be satisfied consistent with the oneflesh unity that Jesus addresses, a union of male and female open to the fruitfulness of new life. The teaching of Christ about adultery and divorce also excludes a number of other unchaste actions. Ref. Catholic Answers Magazine, July-August 2013


