
While his membership in the Knights has been a highlight, he calls Grace, his wife of 59 years, and his 25 offspring his personal shining lights and beacons of God's love.



Highlights of the responses received are included here along with the goals they inspired and the progress that has already been made in addressing the identified issues.


Survey Findings:


