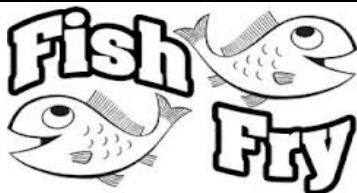
## New Brother Knights

## Pro-Life & Decency Report

### The Gift of Siblings

If you are worn out from all the negative comments regarding larger families, a recent study shows that the best gift you can give your children is siblings. Researchers found an increase in marital stability for children from larger families. Another study found kindergarten children from large families rated as better socialized through adolescence, when only-children tended to catch up socially.

People in larger families have opportunities to learn sharing, taking turns, cooperating and advocating for one's own needs. But these skills don't happen automatically ...adult members must teach children these skills.


Consider these ideas to help your children optimize sibling interactions:

1. Plan one-on-one time with each child. If brothers and sisters get the impression that there just isn't enough love and attention to go around, they will tear at each other. Getting regular one-on-one time with each child is one way to solve this.
2. Use do-overs to teach positive interactions. When one child speaks inappropriately to a sibling, give them better words to express their feelings respectfully and have him actually use those words. When you are serious, they will do it.
3. Encourage teamwork and mutual service. It is good for kids to have individual chores, but it is equally important to sometimes have them work together. Completing a chore as a team requires each member to work to their full potential, but also to help their siblings. Encourage kids to perform little acts of kindness for each other.

Getting this started can require some parental encouragement and correction.

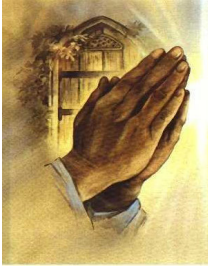
