Our next tournament date is also Groundhog Day and Super Bowl Sunday! All Knights & Guests welcome...hope to see you there!



Scholarship Applicant Eligibility Requirements:

- Must be a practicing Catholic; St Jerome, St Anastasia or Visitation parishioner
- Must be graduating (8th or 12th grader) from a Westchester/Playa del Rey area school or a high school attended by area students
- Must submit completed applications, assigned topics essays and letter of recommendation by April 19 due date
- Children/grandchildren of Council 3744 Knights (dues paying , honorary or honorary life members) may participate even if they do not live in the area, belong to a local parish or attend a local school if they meet other requirements.

As Scholarship Chairman, I provide eligible students the opportunity to apply for one of our ten \$1,000 scholarships, arrange for application judges and distribute completed packages for judging. I then tabulate the judges' scores to determine the Scholarship Award Winners.



Insurance Field Agent Report

Update Your Beneficiaries

Sometimes it is easy to overlook the simplest of things...take the beneficiaries on your life insurance policies, for instance.

If your policy was applied for and issued several years ago, it could very well be that the person you originally selected as the beneficiary is no longer the person you would want to receive the policy proceeds. If you bought the policy when you were single, for example, you may have named your parents as beneficiaries. If you have since married, that should be updated to reflect your spouse or your children as beneficiaries.

Most people list a primary beneficiary, who is specifically designated as the first in priority to receive policy proceeds. We also encourage the naming of a contingent beneficiary, as alternate person designated to receive policy proceeds, usually in the event that the original beneficiary pre-deceases the insured.

I routinely reach out to my policyholders for an annual review appointment, usually near the anniversary date of your policy (the date the policy was originally issued). One of the matters that I'll discuss during this review is the status of your beneficiary designations. If they need updating, and they often do, I can complete the paperwork during that appointment.

We can also discuss any new insurance needs you may want to consider.

I look forward to meeting with each of you to discuss your family's needs.
