I have recently been witness to an unvielding, undeniable and pure holy presence of faith. It came to me while visiting Fr Kolling at his new residence at Nazareth House. I try to visit him once a week. Here is a Priest that physically suffers every day, yet does not complain about anything, instead feeling blessed every day. He has severe sugar diabetes, glaucoma (both eyes), Hepatitis C, bad swelling of his feet and hands (can no longer wear solid shoes), severe neck and back pain (he can't lift his head and needs a 3rd surgery), uses a medical carrier that is surgically inserted into his abdomen and is mostly confined to a wheel chair. When you ask Fr. Kolling how he is doing, he will look at you and say with a smile, "I'm doing just fine". A person must dig deeper with him to uncover the ailments I mentioned. During my visit last week, I noticed the top of his feet were bleeding and bandaged so I asked about it. He told me the problem is due to his diabetes and started to talk about it. During the conversation, he paused, as if he was listening to someone else speak, then looked around and upward as I was sitting next to him. I asked Fr Kolling what was the matter and he looked at me and profoundly said, "my Son, absolutely nothing is wrong, everything is wonderful". I consider myself to have considerable faith, however, at that moment my faith seemed to be visualized through him. We both sat quietly for about two minutes before finishing our conversation.

So I ask all of my Brother Knights; how pure is your Faith? Do you truly believe in God and Jesus Christ? Do you pray each day? How can you discern a conversation between you and God? Faith is not something you tell people you have, we just know it's there inside of us intrinsically. We need to demonstrate our Faith to know we truly believe. This is not easy, and takes learning to outwardly exhibit and demonstrate what we inwardly know and pray. Fr. Kolling has tremendous Faith. He Loves Jesus and the Father unequivocally and you can sense this and observe it by just being with him. That's not to say he is not without his own judgments, however, he forges through each day knowing that he is witness to internal life ever after. That is Faith.

Two Recent Victories Over TV Indecency

American Family Association (AFA)'s OneMillionMoms (1MM) continued to impact the television landscape with two recent victories.

In Oct, Capital One launched a commercial with actor Samuel L. Jackson cursing in the ad. Less than a week after 1MM members began contacting the company, the ad was edited, removing the profanity.

Also in Oct, NBC closed Camp, a new fall program, after 1MM began asking show sponsors to end advertising, which most did. "Camp was irresponsible and tasteless," said 1MM director Monica Cole. "The show featured immoral behavior in a positive light while attempting to draw in young viewers with the title and adolescent plot of the program. We're pleased with NBC's decision," she said.
