



# **Grand Knight's Faith Message**

What is heaven? Heaven is the endless moment of love. Nothing separates us from God, whom our soul loves and has sought our whole life long. Together with all the angels and saints we will be able to rejoice forever in and with God. If you have ever observed a couple looking at each other lovingly or a nursing baby looking in his mother's eyes as though it wanted to store up every smile forever, then you have some inkling of heaven. To be able to see God face to face - that is like one, single, never ending moment of love.

What is purgatory? Purgatory, often imagined as a place, is actually a condition.

Someone who dies in God's grace (and therefore at peace with God) still who needs purification before he can see God face to face is in purgatory. When Peter had betrayed Jesus, the Lord turned to look at Peter: "...and Peter went out and wept bitterly", a feeling like being in purgatory. Only after this purifying pain are we capable of meeting his loving gaze in heavenly joy.

So I ask, have you ever felt the most pure giving of yourself to Love? A feeling that overtakes your physical and emotional body and spirit without thought or constraints. A uncontrollable loving emotion, sometimes crying and feeling of a silent peace? Perhaps then you have felt the presence of Jesus Christ or even the Father; if even for that brief moment. We Catholics believe in the Resurrection of the body and spirit, but do You believe in the forgiveness of Love?






