Decency Report

TV Rating System Flawed

The FCC created the TV Parental Guidelines Monitoring Board in the mid 1990s, responding to public demands for oversight of explicit programming. Composed of 24 members (19 of whom are industry insiders), its job is to monitor a system to assigned one of six ratings to indicate age-appropriate content of TV programs. The rating for each show is essentially determined by the very people who create and/or broadcast it, and therein lies the problem. Ad rates are based on a show's audience size and, since a more restrictive age rating may reduce the audience size, it is in a network's own interests to apply for the least restrictive rating.

So is the system working? The Parents Television Council (PTC) has been asking this for some time and, based on a recent study on media violence, the answer appears to be a resounding "No!" In order for the system to work, ratings must be accurate, consistent, transparent and accountable. Isn't it time for a ratings systems overhaul, with parents and families having a seat at the table?

PTC President Tim Winter cites two particular shortcomings of the current system as applied to broadcast television: (1) discrepancies in how broadcast programs are perceived compared to cable and (2) inconsistencies in how broadcast shows are rated. Parents often perceive broadcast TV as safer for children than the cable counterpart, however, the study revealed that broadcast network shows often match or exceed the volume and degree of violence in cable programs. Parents simply cannot rely on the industry's application of the current system to warn them of explicit adult content.

Parents instinctively protect their children from harmful content because they know they are impacted by what they see. Winter notes: "But they cannot protect their children by relying on an inaccurate rating system. The need for reform is urgent, and the time for reform is now." (Ref.: PTC Insider, March 2014)






