Decency Report

Contraception Products

Some retail stores rightly recognize that tobacco products are incompatible with their mission as a healthcare provider. But other products also clash with its mission: the over-the-counter availability of Plan B and the prescription distribution of Ella.

Access to plan B does not reduce the number of unintended pregnancies or abortions. Aside from being ineffective, over-the-counter access to emergency contraception may be harmful to women's health. It isolates at-risk women from the medical care they need to diagnose sexually transmitted diseases and access appropriate contraceptive counseling. In certain circumstances, emergency contraception may act by blocking a new conceived embryo from implanting rather than preventing fertilization. And not all consumers will be aware of the difference. This is not a product to be sold over-the-counter with no more consultation than buying candy.

In addition, these drugs have been tested for safety only in women 18 to 45, and under conditions where these women use the drug only once in a cycle. Plan B puts powerful hormones in the hands of the youngest teens, in whom its safety has never been studied. At a stage when their reproductive organs are maturing, these girls will be exposed to unknown doses of hormones for an unknown duration, and in some cases, under no medical supervision. For all these reasons, retailers and all responsible healthcare providers should rethink how they sell emergency contraception. (Ref: Population Research Institute Review of March / April 2014)

Grand Knight's Faith Message

What is eternal life? - Eternal life begins with Baptism. It continues through death and will have no end. Even when we are simply in love, we want this state of affairs to last forever. "God is love", says the First Letter of John (1 Jn 4:16). "Love", says the First Letter to the Corinthians, "never ends" (1 Cor 13:8). God is eternal because he is love; and love is everlasting because it is divine. If we are in love, we enter into God's endless presence.

Will we be brought to judgment after death? - The so-called particular or personal judgment occurs at the moment of death of the individual. The general judgment, which is also called the Last Judgment, occurs on the Last Day, at the end of the world, when the Lord comes again. In dying every man arrives at the moment of truth. Please keep Luci, Jim and the entire Williams family in your prayers.




