The St Jerome Conference of the Society of St Vincent de Paul (SJC-SSVdP) and the St Jerome Parish sponsor a Soup Kitchen the 3rd Saturday of each month from 10:30am to 12:00noon, providing a hearty meal to the elderly needy, poor, and homeless...anyone who comes to enjoy a community lunch is welcomed. Soup Kitchen Coordinator Jude Ramlochan starts each meal with grilled ham and cheese sandwiches and a cup of fresh fruit. Msgr Priebe then leads everyone in a prayer of thanks for the meal prepared fresh by volunteers.

On Sat Oct 18, the Parish Hall looked like a restaurant buffet, filling 3 long serving tables with salad, fresh fruit, chicken noodle soup, chili, blue plate special casserole, fried chicken, corn bread, bagels and numerous desserts. Decency Report

Calif to Catholic Colleges: Any Abortion, Any Time, Period

The CA Dept of Managed Health Care (DMHC), bowing to political pressure from Planned Parenthood and its supporters, has told health insurers that they cannot sell two Catholic universities any product that does not cover all abortions for employees. The notice contradicts the Dept's own ruling earlier in the year that Jesuit-run **Loyola Marymount** in Los Angeles and **Santa Clara University** are within the law by offering health plans that do not cover elective abortions.

California's attempt to reverse course is expected to set in motion one or more legal battles. Regulation of managed health care plans is governed by the Knox Keene Act, enacted in 1975. DMHC contends that the law and several Supreme Court rulings support the inclusion of abortion in managed health care plans.

Once again, despite virtually unrestricted access to abortion for girls and women in California, proponents of abortion are trying to force their view on Catholic institutions. Even the Patient Protect and Affordable Care Act does not enact such a draconian rule. The Federal law mandates at least one plan be available in each state that excludes most abortion coverage.






Fish Fry Season Going Strong!

By-Law Change Vote at Wed Nov 5 Meeting

At the Sept 2 meeting, members voted unanimously to put a change in By-Laws up to a vote of members. Pursuant to By-Law Article IX, proposed changes must be published in the Bulletin 30 days prior to the formal vote. Following is the required information for members, along with a brief explanation of each change (changes are shown as **bold**).

Article I, Sec. 3 ...annual dues of members shall be \$55...

Change: Dues have been \$45 for over 10 years. Current member services cost \$68 and this overdue change narrows the difference.

Article II, Sec. 2 ...election of officers shall be by ballot **for contested positions and** by voice vote for uncontested positions.

Change: Provides streamlined vote for uncontested positions.

Article V, Sec 1

After reading in of candidate applications, the Grand Knight shall call for a voice vote of acceptance. With unanimous voice vote approval, candidate will be deemed accepted for admission. If a single objection is presented during the voice vote, the Grand Knight will move to a formal ballot vote defined in Sec. 2.

Change: Provides streamlined vote for uncontested admissions.

Article VI, Sec.2

- (a) Memorial Committee as required by Article VII.
- (b) Other Committees as may be required by Laws of the Order or these by-laws.

Change: Provides language to define the Memorial Committee as a permanent standing committee of Council.

A full marked up copy of the existing By-Laws with these changes included can be seen on the Council website at www.kofc3744.org on the Web Links tab.

By-Law changes are an infrequent event, so please plan on attending the Council Meeting on Nov 5. Your participation in this process is important to your Council officers.




