Attending council meetings is where you will learn about our great programs, receive info and learn about opportunities where you can make a difference in our council and Parishes! Please make the effort to attend!!



Can you believe it's already Dec? This year has flown by. The birthday of our Lord Jesus Christ is soon upon us and is an amazing time for Catholics. We celebrate His birth by going to Mass, through our charitable works, Love, Peace and Prayer. I ask that you keep your family, country, and all those less fortunate in your Prayers this time of year and every day. The beginning of Advent is a time of preparation for the coming of Christ this year it begins Nov 30. Advent is also the start of the liturgical year in the Roman Catholic Church. Immediate needs for the family will be 2 beds: a full size for the mother and a twin bed for the son. Other items that the Sister of the Home, Sr Judy, thought they needed would be a blender and a microwave and maybe a small gift for her son. You may also send them to the Hall address. All gifts need to be received by Dec 19.

## Decency Report

### Rating Retailers for "Faithful" Christmas Marketing



American Family Association reviewed four areas to see if a company was "Christmas-friendly" in their ads: print media (newspaper inserts), broadcast media (radio/TV), website and/or personal visits to the store.

If a company's ad refers to items associated with Christmas (trees, wreaths, lights, etc.) it was considered as an attempt to reach "Christmas" shoppers.

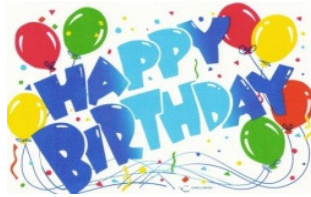
