Decency Report

The United Nations's Radical Abortion Agenda

A new United Nations report, called the World Survey on the Role of Women in Development 2014: Gender Equality and Sustainable Development, is written in a kind of code. Words and expressions are used that sound reasonable - what could be wrong with "gender equality," for example? - but actually have quite radical and subversive meanings that are lost on the general public.

"Reproductive health"

The goal of "reproductive health" programs is actually population control. Women and girls are to encouraged to contracept, sterilize, and abort their children. The reason why this "recommendation" is included in the section "on sustainable development," is that it is really about limiting population growth.

"Sustainable"

Whenever you read the word sustainable, as in "Sustainable Development" or "Sustainable Population" you should substitute the words "limit" or "restrict." It actually means something like, "... the promotion of sterilization and abortion."

"Safe abortion"

Safe abortion sounds more woman-friendly than simply saying abortion. But it is used within the UN system to refer to the legalization of abortion on demand.

"Gender Equality"

The kind of equality that UN bureaucrats have in mind would end the natural complementarity between the sexes that binds husband and wife together. The UN is "instructing" the nanny state to force husbands and wives to do equal amounts of cooking, cleaning, childcare, etc.

Grand Knight Faith Message

Why is the Church called apostolic?

The Church is called apostolic because she was founded by the apostles, holds fast to their Tradition, and is governed by their successors. Jesus called the apostles to be his closest collaborators. They were his eyewitnesses. After his Resurrection, he appeared to them repeatedly. He bestowed on them the Holy Spirit and sent them as his authoritative messengers to all the world. They assured unity in the early Church. They conferred their mission and authority upon their successors, the bishops, through the laying on of hands.

This process is called apostolic succession.

How is the one, holy, catholic, and apostolic Church structured?

In the Church there are the laity and clerics (clergy). As children of God, they are of equal dignity. They have equally important but different tasks. The mission of the laity is to direct the whole world toward the kingdom of God. In addition, there are the ordained ministers (clerics), who have the duties of ecclesiastical governance, teaching, and sanctification. In both states of life, there are Christians who place themselves at God's disposal in a special way through celibacy, poverty, and obedience, for examples. Every Christian has the duty to bear witness to the Gospel by his own life. But God walks a special path with each person. Some he sends as laymen, so that they might build up the kingdom of God by their family and occupation in the midst of the world. For this purpose, he bestows on them in Baptism and Confirmation all the necessary gifts of the Holy Spirit. Others he entrusts with the pastoral ministry; they are to govern, teach, and sanctify his people. No one can take this duty upon himself; the Lord himself must send him on his way with his divine power through Holy Orders, so that he can act in the place of Christ and administer the sacraments.

Insurance Field Agent Report

Plan for this Tax Day and into the Future



April 15 (tax day) is right around the corner. It's a popular time of year to encourage opening/adding to an IRA retirement annuity or similar tax-saving vehicle. Perhaps someone has tried to convince you to open an account, touting the interest rate that money in one of these accounts can earn. Let me join the chorus of folks encouraging you to consider an annuity, but for a different reason.

Certainly, contributing money to a Knights of Columbus annuity allows you to save some money in income taxes and our annuities do pay a competitive interest rate, consistent with our primary goal of absolute safety of principal.
