

Grand Knight Faith Message

Proof of the Resurrection: No proofs for the Resurrection exist in the scientific sense but there are strong testimonies by large numbers of contemporaries of the event. The oldest written testimony is St. Paul's letter to the Corinthians twenty years after Christ's death: "For I delivered to you as of first importance what I also received, that Christ died for our sins in accordance with the Scriptures, that he was buried, that he was raised on the third day in accordance with the Scriptures, and that he appeared to Cephas, then to the Twelve. Then he appeared to more than five hundred brethren at one time, most of whom are still alive, though some have fallen asleep."

Paul recorded a living tradition that was present in the Christian community shortly after Jesus' death and Resurrection, when he himself became a Christian on the basis of his own staggering encounter with the risen Lord. The physical encounters with the risen Lord ended with Christ's Ascension into heaven but afterward, and even today, encounters with the Lord continue: Jesus Christ lives!
