Timeline of the Earliest Days of a New Human Life

The timeline of the development of the fetus from conception, only reinforces the conclusion that a human baby is growing from the very first moment. This list of development milestones from the beginning, was compiled on the website at: https://prolifeacrossaerica.org



Days from conception

- 0 With 23 chromosomes from each parent, a unique human being is conceived.
 - A tiny living organism weighing only 15 ten-millionth of a gram. Life begins.
- 1 First cell divides into two, then two into four, and so on.
 - Each cell divides again and again as they travel toward the womb to grow.
- 18 Heart begins to beat with the baby's own blood.
- 28 Baby has eyes, ears, and even a tongue!
- 28 Muscles are developing along the future spine. Arms and legs are budding.
- 30 Child has grown 10,000 times to 1/4" long. Brain has human proportions.
- 42 Skeleton is formed, reflex responses have begun, brain waves detectable.
 - Jaw formed with teeth and taste buds, fingers and toes are developing.
 - Unborn baby begins to swallow amniotic fluid.
- 44 Unborn baby's facial muscles develop and eyelids begin to form.
 - Elbows take shape, immature internal organs and 99% of muscles are present.
- 45 Chest and abdomen are fully formed.
 - Baby is making body movements, 12 weeks before mother may notice any.
 - Swimming in amniotic fluid, the baby now looks like a miniature human infant.
- 52 Spontaneous movement begins.,
 - Baby develops a whole collection of different moves over the next 4 weeks.
- 56 Baby, about 1 1/8" and weighing 1/30th of an ounce, yet well proportioned.
 - Every organ is present, heartbeat is steady.
 - Stomach produces digestive juices, liver makes blood cells.
 - Kidneys begin to function.
