St Jerome Priests' Retirement Mass on June 28

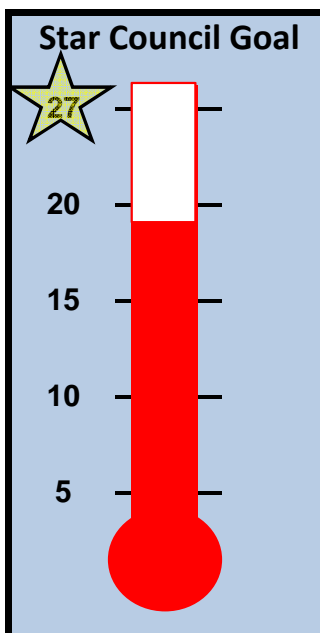

Decency Report

The Sanctity of Sunday



It is good realize that Christians celebrate the Resurrection every single Sunday of the year. It is fitting, of course, that we keep the third commandment by attending Mass each Sunday, but is that enough? You might be surprised to learn the Catechism of the Catholic Church uses strong language about what activity is appropriate to the day.

“It is a day to protest against servitude of work and worship of money.” (2172) Also - “the institution of the Lord’s day helps everyone enjoy adequate rest and leisure to cultivate their familial, cultural, social and religious lives” (2185)

It is difficult to understand how a trip to the mall for new shoes or to the home center for weekend project supplies or even the grocery store in preparation for the coming week is in keeping with the spirit of keeping holy the Lord’s Day. By conducting our retail business on Sundays, we are requiring others to do work: stock clerks, sales people and many others.

We can also shut off all the screens - smart phones, computers, tablets, and TVs. “Sunday is a time for reflection, silence, cultivation of the mind and meditation which furthers the growth of the Christian interior life.” (2186)

“Through Sunday rest” writes Pope St John Paul II in his apostolic letter *Dies Domini*, “daily concerns and tasks can find their proper perspective. The material things about which we worry give way to spiritual values; in a moment of encounter and less pressured exchange, we see the true face of the people with whom we live.”

So, take back Sundays. Skip the shopping and shut off the screens. Turn to the people with whom we live and, in so doing, toward God.

Grand Knight Faith Message

Who can be baptized, and what is required of a candidate? Any person who is not can be baptized. The only prerequisite is faith, which must be professed publicly at Baptism. A person who turns to Christianity is not just changing a world view but traveling a path of learning (catechumenate), becoming a new person through conversion, and especially through the gift of Baptism. That person is now a living member of the Body of Christ.

Why can infants be Baptised? From antiquity the Church practiced infant Baptism for one reason: before we decide on God, God has decided on us. Baptism is a grace, a gift of God, who accepts us unconditionally. Believing parents who want the best for their child want Baptism also, in which the child is freed from the influence of original sin and the power of death.
