
Tue Dec 15 we will hold our "Knight Before Christmas" First Degree! I challenge each Brother Knight to please bring one (or more) new members into our order!!

We were shocked and saddened by the unexpected passing of St Anastasia pastor and Brother Knight **Msgr Gabriel Gonzales** on Nov 9. Many Brother Knight's attended the Rosary Vigil, the funeral Mass at the Cathedral and the parish services at St Anastasia Church. Everyone was struck at how deeply Msgr Gabe was loved as a loyal servant of God.





As a Council, we were unprepared for the news we received shortly after Msgr Gabe's passing. In his last days, Msgr Gabe was in the process of preparing a gift to Council 3744 for our help to him.

In 2014, the Pastor's Plaza was dedicated in the courtyard outside St Anastasia Church to honor the parish's pastors.

If a company's advertising has references to items associated with Christmas (trees, wreaths, lights, etc.), it was considered as an attempt to reach "Christmas" shoppers.
