Once again, thank you for your past support and looking forward to another successful campaign for this worthy charity.



#### Where is Your Mountain?


As we focus on the Transfiguration, I would like to reflect on prayer. Prayer is a very common, popular activity. Even many people who profess no belief in God still pray!







## **Grand Knight Faith Message**

What is Venial Sin?



Venial sin is a less serious offense against God's law, which doesn't deprive the soul of sanctifying grace and can be pardoned without sacramental confession.

#### How can a sin be venial?

A sin can be venial in two ways:

- when the evil done is not seriously wrong;
- when the evil done is seriously wrong, but the sinner sincerely believes it is only slightly wrong, or does not give full consent to it.

#### How does venial sin harm us?

Venial sin harms us by making us less fervent in the service of God, by weakening our power to resist mortal sin, and by making us deserving of God's punishments in this life or in purgatory.
