Decency Report

Safe Haven Baby Boxes

It took Monica Kelsey more than two years to see the nation's first safe haven baby box installed in her hometown of Woodburn, Indiana when Indiana Gov Mike Pence signed House Enrolled Act 1016 into law in 2015.

This law provides a safe place where a newborn can be placed anonymously in a newborn safety incubator outside a facility. The person outside the facility is unable to access the newborn after the baby has been placed in the safety incubator.

Once in the incubator, the newborn is only accessible to emergency medical service providers inside the facility.

The women love their children and want to do with best for the child, without being shamed for this decision.



Kelsey hopes that these boxes will be an extension of safe haven laws, which are on the books in all 50 states. Mothers can relinquish their newborns at designated s safe haven locations without fear of legal issues, and this takes away any face-to face interaction during the surrender.

The Knights of Columbus of Indiana have vowed to pay for the first 100 boxes at a cost of \$1,500 to \$2,000 each.


