Decency Report

Abortion Clinics Closing

A Planned Parenthood abortion clinic is closing in Wisconsin. The reason? One state pro-life group says the abortion giant has had problems locating an abortion practitioner for the facility and fewer women are seeking abortions.

Pro-Life Wisconsin told LifeNews it is celebrating the permanent closure of the Planned Parenthood abortion facility in Grand Chute, Wisconsin. State Director Dan Miller recognized the strong pro-life supporters who were praying daily for the facility to close.

"For Planned Parenthood, it's all about the bottom line – if you don't produce, you're gone," the group continued. "The Grand Chute facility wasn't killing enough babies, so they will close. Last year the Planned Parenthood clinic in Appleton, in northeastern Wisconsin, suspended abortions." A key factor is that current law requires that women seeking abortions in Wisconsin must be given the opportunity to see their unborn children through ultrasound.



Only Having "Through Work" Insurance Doesn't Work
