Exploiting Children

National Geographic announced that their January 2017 edition would feature a nine year old boy who wants to be perceived as a girl.

The magazine's editor wrote, "She has lived as an openly transgender girl since age 5, and she captured the complexity of the conversation around gender. Today, we're not only talking about gender roles for boys and girls—we're talking about our evolving understanding of people on the gender spectrum."

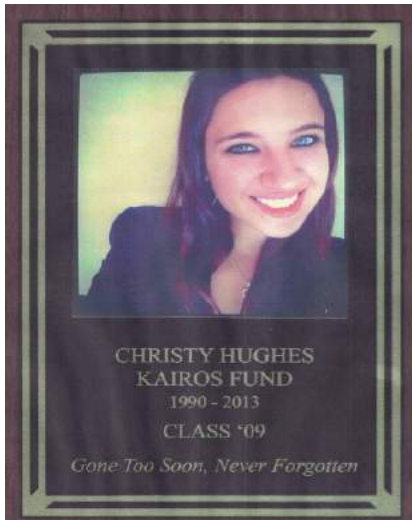
