How Knights Came to Honor Columbus



With the recent action taken by the Los Angeles City Council to remove Columbus Day from the city list of recognized holidays, it is interesting to know a little more about how Christopher Columbus was chosen by Fr Michael McGivney to be the namesake of our order.

Following is an explanation of the origin of the Knights of Columbus, recently published on the Supreme website.

"Ever wonder why Father Michael J. McGivney chose Christopher Columbus as the namesake for his new benefit society? Why would he and his Irish Knights name their Catholic fraternity after an Italian explorer rather than a saint?

Because, in a time when anti-Catholic and anti-immigration hostilities ran strong, the American public embraced this famous explorer.

Father McGivney and his Knights understood that using Columbus as their Order's namesake asserted an important truth: that not only was there a place for Catholics and immigrants within American society, but that such a person had already played a part in creating the young, free world around them.

Today, there are those who contest Columbus' achievements and protest the national holiday held in his honor. However, we Knights celebrate his holiday, knowing that Columbus gave voice and representation to generations of Catholics, helping pave a path for the diverse society we have today."

Decency Report

Trans-gender Ideology

Bishop Davies (of the Diocese of Shrewsbury, England) cited "the [recent] Popes, [who] have warned that the radical ideology of gender would challenge the truth about the human person...."

Bishop Davies relied on Pope Benedict XVI for a definitive explanation for the "thinking" behind the raft of laws proliferating in Western democracies.

Pope Benedict said: "According to this philosophy, sex is no longer a given element of nature that man has to accept and personally make sense of; it is a social role that we choose for ourselves, whereas in the past it was chosen for us by society."

Calling this a "profound falsehood" and an "anthropological revolution," Benedict said it empowered believers to "dispute that they have a nature, given by their bodily identity, that serves as a defining element of the human being."



Pope John Paul II provided "a providential guide" to resist gender ideology in his Theology of the Body, where he stated, "No amount of scientific exploration can replace the truth that our bodies reveal us, giving form to our innermost being a unique personality."

Bishop Davies is careful to insist, "We must always show genuine love and understanding to those who are swayed or fall victim to the errors of our times. However, we can never compromise the truth of our faith nor allow the truth about the human person to be obscured, for that would be a false charity." 'We can never compromise the truth' on gender.'



The Chris Award (Knight of the Year) was presented to Brother **Tony Holloway**.




Fish Fry Season Opens THIS Month - Nov 3


