Decency Report

Marriage - What is it?

Marriage is a practice common to all cultures in all ages. It is, therefore, a natural institution, common to all mankind. Basically, marriage is a union between a man and a woman for the purpose of procreation and mutual support. Each person in a marriage gives up some rights over his or her life in exchange for rights over the life of the other spouse. While divorce has existed throughout history, it has been rare until recent centuries, which indicates that, even in its natural form, marriage is meant to be a lifelong union.



The Elements of a Natural Marriage

There are four elements common to natural marriage throughout history: It is a union of opposite sexes, It is a lifelong union, ending only with the death of one spouse, It excludes a union with any other person so long as the marriage exists, and Its lifelong nature and exclusiveness are guaranteed by contract. So, even at a natural level, divorce, adultery, and "homosexual marriage" are not compatible with marriage. And a lack of commitment means that no marriage has taken place.

Marriage as a Supernatural Institution

In the Catholic Church, however, marriage is more than a natural institution; it was elevated by Christ Himself, in His participation in the wedding at Cana (John 2:1-11), to be one of the seven sacraments. A marriage between two Christians, therefore, has a supernatural element as well as a natural one.
