ProLife Report - Conscience Rights

Immediately following the [November] election, the Trump administration released three new pro-life regulations to help protect the conscience rights of families and employers when purchasing health insurance. The first two regulations seek to provide employers with religious and moral exemptions to the “HHS Contraceptive Mandate.” In addition, another rule released by HHS last week would undo a federal regulation that currently allows health insurance companies to collect premiums for abortion coverage and health care coverage together on the same bill. Under the ACA, the government is required to collect a “separate payment” for coverage of elective abortion. [This regulation will also preserve the conscience rights of payees.]



How should social and economic life be pursued? It should be pursued according to its own proper methods within the sphere of the moral order, at the service of the whole human being and of the entire human community in keeping with social justice. Social and economic life should have the human person as its author, center, and goal.

What would be opposed to the social doctrine of the Church? Opposed to the social doctrine of the Church are economic and social systems that sacrifice the basic rights of persons or that make profit their exclusive norm or ultimate end. For this reason the Church rejects the ideologies associated in modern times with Communism or with atheistic and totalitarian forms of socialism. But in the practice of capitalism the Church also rejects self centered individualism and an absolute primacy of the laws of the marketplace over human labor.
