
Grand Knight Message

Commitment to others through shared fraternal activities can emulate Christ's selflessness, benevolence, altruism, and above all love, but only when expressed by deeds. Charity, through acts of volunteerism channels almsgiving. Unity, exemplified by working together promotes common cause. Fraternity, facilitates camaraderie and esprit de corps, while Patriotism is exemplified through our assistance of countrymen in need.

Commitment to our Catholic Church's growth and good works can take many forms, but they all involve active participation. As our Supreme Council notes: "Joining your local council does not mean that you need to sacrifice quality time with your family. In fact, volunteering an hour here or an hour there with your family can make an enormous impact in your life and in the lives of others." Our fraternal order's publication: *The 24 Hour Knight*, lists a minimal goal of volunteerism as one full day's work each year, and through just a couple hours at a time. Dedication of one's talents can be broken down to something as simple as spending:

•12 hours a year reading the weekly parish bulletin, state and local council newsletters, Columbia magazine, or surfing the local, state, and Supreme Council websites.

•2 hours a year volunteering at one or more of Council #3744's many charitable events such as a parish carnival, fish fry, or assistance at St. Margaret's Center, Alexandria House, and Rancho San Antonio.

•2 hours a year attending, with family, the Council's Memorial Mass, Quarterly Communion Mass, or Rosary at the Shrine promoting decency and the sanctity of life at Holy Cross Cemetery.

•2 hours a year on a Council-sponsored Church, community, Council family, or youth project of his choosing.

•2 hours a year attending one or more Council #3744 meetings.

•4 hours a year enjoying (again, with the entire family) a Council #3744 social function like dinner at the hall, the Council picnic, or joining the Knights of Columbus' crew at Westchester's 4th of July celebration.

Each of us is a unique being with his own special talents. No one has the time or wherewithal to attend every meeting, help at every charitable function, or financially support all the worthy causes Council #3744 sponsors. We do, however, each have some time to set aside in service to One and all through occasional Council activities. 
Scholarship Applicant Eligibility Requirements:

OR - Child or grandchild of a dues paying (or life) member of KofC Council 3744 (whether affiliated with a local parish or not).




