

# **Tested by Fire and Darkness**

April's Holy Week fire at Cathédrale Notre-Dame de Paris resulted in heartbreak, but was met by acts of extraordinary heroism. Heartbreak caused by irreplaceable relics set under siege by indiscriminate flames, and heroic responders who quelled their fury while saving pieces of priceless history and so very much more.

The Chaplain of Paris firefighters, Father Jean-Marc Fournier, entered the burning cathedral at night, and as worldwide press reports have celebrated: He retrieved France's iconic Crown of Thorns relic, obtained and brought to Paris by King Louis IX in the 13th century. What has received far less publicity, however, is what else Father Fournier risked his life to protect while being tested by fire and darkness.


The same brave priest who earlier served as a military chaplain in war-torn Afghanistan, and where according to his own testimony he was "seized by fear," entered the flames of France's seat of Catholicism to rescue the Blessed Sacrament. The Body and Blood of Jesus Christ is central to our Roman Catholic faith, and Father Fournier's fidelity to something nonbelievers might find easily replaceable, is testament to a heroic man's devotion, and a worthy example of true belief for us all to reflect upon.

# **Tested by Fire and Darkness (continued)**

As Pope Francis eloquently stated on Holy Thursday, and shortly afer the Paris fire: "In the Eucharist you really meet Jesus, share His life, feel His love; there you experience that His death and Resurrection are for you."

The edifice of Notre-Dame is iconic to the entire Christian world, but it is what takes place inside the church, and its reason for existing, that is of utmost importance. Supreme Knight Carl Anderson recalled that on Good Friday 1919, the Knights of Columbus held a service at Notre-Dame Cathedral for the public veneration of the cross, and that ten-thousand Americans were in attendance that day, just five months after armistice was signed ending World War I. They came to give thanks, and like Father Fournier, expressed their fidelity to what the French call: la Fête-Dieu, or Corpus Christi – the Body of Christ.

Father Fournier's faithful devotion to the Blessed Sacrament reminds us what is most important to our faith, while the Notre-Dame fire demonstrates how weak our humanly existence is without Him in our lives. It is something we need to reflect upon on a daily basis: Why are we Catholic, and why are we Knights? Let us pray that when our time comes, and we are tested by fire and darkness, that we respond in a manner worthy of the example provided by France's courageous Father. God bless the heroes that emerge during the darkness and who are tested by the flame. Vivat Jesus!


