A special thank you to **Bill Thompson PGK** and his crew for putting together our successful Council Awards Dinner. Job well done Brothers!

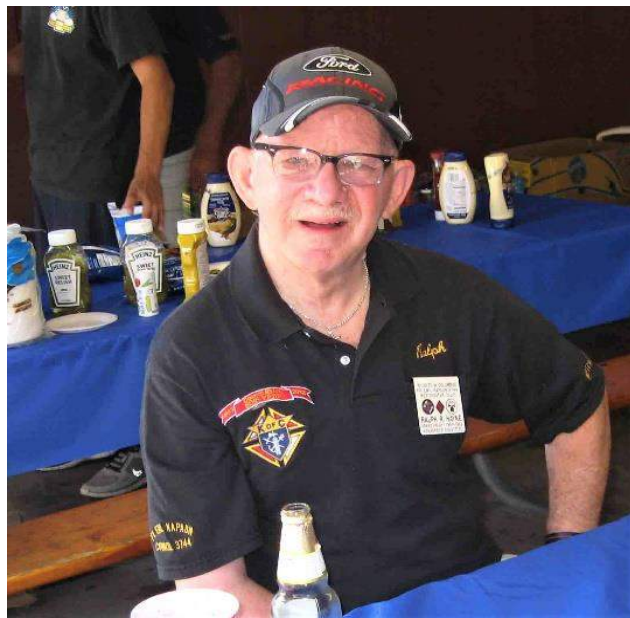

Rancho San Antonio Raffle Huge Success!

I am honored to report that our ticket sales for the Rancho San Antonio drive were \$8,560, exceeding last year's total, and my goal, of \$6,500. Brother John, at Rancho San Antonio, is well aware of our council's outstanding effort. 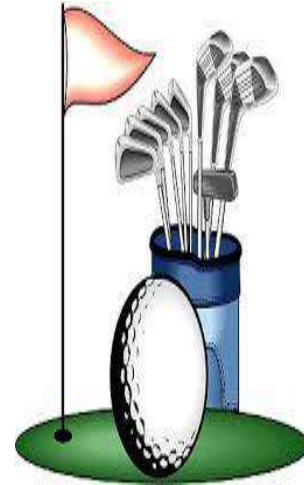
