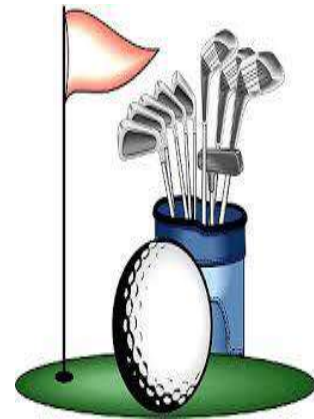

Life is What You Make It, Especially When it Comes to Attending Mass (continued)

It took the love of a good woman to get me back in the fold. My future wife attended weekly Mass with her mom, and joining them each Sunday morning was a way for me to spend more time with her once we began dating. Then something truly amazing happened along the way, and I assure you it wasn't intentional. When I began to listen and learn the Gospels for the very first time in my life, I found them interesting. I began enjoying my Church experience, being with loved ones, and in the process I even managed to find true faith for the first time in my life. It wasn't just a desire to believe, but absolute certainty in our divine God, and that's something you can't lie to yourself about.

We are always going to retain things from any experience in life, and I did have a foundation to start with once I returned to Church. Even so, as is common among Catholics, I really didn't know the Gospels: unlike one of my sisters-in-law who was raised in the Christian Reform Church, and in spite of not practicing for decades, she still never misses a Jeopardy question about the Bible. Love of the Gospels is key, or as Pope Francis tells us: "Be constantly nourished by the Word of God." My problem, like many cradle Catholics who walk away, is that I never took time to listen, contemplate, or try to understand the readings I heard at Mass. After returning to Church in my late 30s, I really began to appreciate the Gospels and homilies, and much like during my senior year of college, I was able to start connecting the dots, and apply their lessons to my life.

Because of COVID, many Catholics have had a validated excuse not to attend Mass in person. For some, it's become easier to meet our weekly obligation by simply livestreaming it in the background while sipping a cup of coffee and perusing the morning newspaper. The Mass, however, is what you make it, whether it be background noise or something that impacts your life. Now that Archbishop Gomez has declared that our Churches can resume relatively normal operations, I strongly recommend that everyone who is physically able - turn off their Internet, head back to your Church, and reengage in a manner that allows you to take the time needed to apply what you hear to your life. Mass truly is what I made of it, and you know what? After understanding that simple statement, I'm a much happier person.
