### Knights of Columbus History - A Timeline of Papacy (Part Two)

This month we again look at the history of the Knights, and place it into perspective of who was Pope at the time. Part One appeared in the December 2021 bulletin.

**Venerable Pius XII** (1939-58) As they did during World War I, the Knights again established welfare programs for servicemen during World War II. Afterwards, the Order focused on combatting growing threats posed by communism and fascism through its 1946 Crusade for the Preservation and Promotion of American Ideals. Several hundred radio stations in the U.S. broadcast Knights of Columbus-sponsored programs titled “Safeguards of America.” On Flag Day, June 14, 1954, the Knights successfully lobbied to have “under God” added to the Pledge of Allegiance. On November 17, 1953, Fr. Emil Kapaun Council #3744 received its charter in Westchester.

**St. John XXIII** (1958-63) On January 25, 1959, Pope John announced his intention to convene what became Vatican II (1962-1965) in an effort to unite religious communities. Council #3744 moved into its new hall in Playa del Rey on September 29, 1959. Fourth Degree Knight John F. Kennedy became President of the United States on January 20, 1961. Supreme Knight Luke Hart met Kennedy at the White House in October of that year, and again in 1963 to advocate passage of civil rights legislation.

**St. Paul VI** (1963-78) Vatican II brought great changes to Catholicism. In an effort to help spread the Church’s word, Knights donated a shortwave radio transmitter to the Vatican Transmitting Center in 1966. The current Supreme headquarters in New Haven finalized construction in 1969. The Order agreed to fund uplink transmissions for major worldwide satellite telecasts emanating from the Vatican – a program that continues to allow billions to watch Christmastime Midnight Mass from St. Peter’s Basilica each year.

**Venerable John Paul I** (1978) Pope John Paul I received Supreme Knight Virgil Dechant and other Knights at the pontiff’s first private audience held after his election.

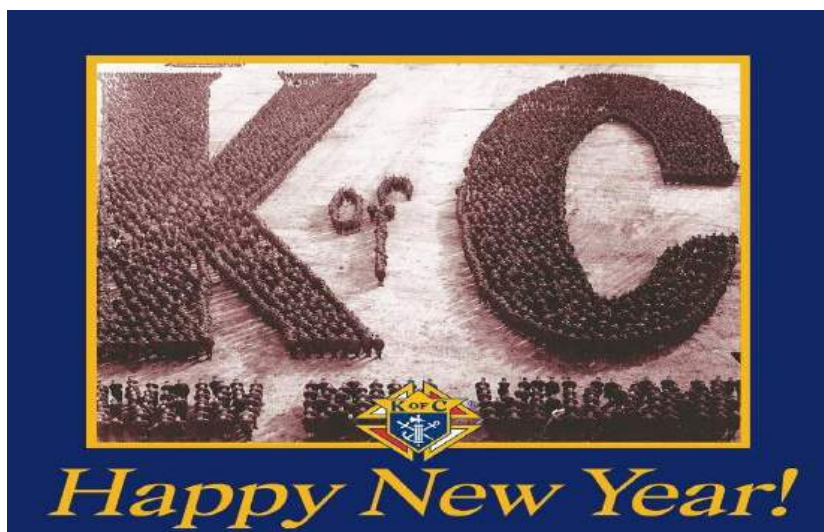
### Knights of Columbus History - A Timeline of Papacy (Part Two) Continued

**St. John Paul II** (1978-2005) Beginning in 1978, each new First Degree Knight received a rosary blessed by the Supreme Chaplain – a practice that continues to this day. To mark the 100th anniversary of the Knights' founding in 1882, President Ronald Reagan spoke at the K of C Supreme Convention in 1982. Also that year, with canonical and civil approval, Father McGivney's remains were removed from his family's cemetery plot in Waterbury for reinterment inside New Haven's St Mary's Church. In 1996, Father McGivney's cause for canonization was opened. On May 21, 2000, Pope John Paul II canonized 25 martyrs of Mexico, including 6 members of the Knights of Columbus.

**Benedict XVI** (2005-2013) On March 16, 2008, Father McGivney was declared "Venerable" by Pope Benedict in recognition of his heroic virtue. In 2010, the Knights dramatically increased financial relief to the victims of natural disaster, especially in Latin America. The Order also focused on efforts to increase outreach and membership in places like South Korea, the Ukraine, and Iraq.

**Francis** (2013-Present) In 2019, the Knights' Ultrasound Initiative reached over 1,000 machines donated to pregnancy centers in furtherance of building a "Culture of Life." On October 31, 2020, Father McGivney was beatified by Pope Francis, and declared "Blessed" by the Church. In 2020, the Knights added a new 3-in-1 Exemplification ceremony to initiate candidates into the Order. In October 2021, Francis venerated a first-class relic of Father McGivney during a meeting with Supreme Knight Patrick Kelly at the Vatican.
