When Knights First Had Fun in Playa Del Rey

Some 48 years before Council #3744's founding in 1953, the Knights of Columbus paid an initial visit to the Pacific Ocean community of Playa del Rey. It was during the Summer of June 1905 when the Knights held their national convention in Los Angeles. A big event staged for the conference was a "Ball by the Seaside." Held at the Pavilion in Playa del Rey, nestled along Del Rey Lagoon, the venue was illuminated by special electric lights, installed specifically for the occasion. They were still a bit of a novelty as Thomas Edison had only been selling light bulbs to the public for about 25 years by then.

The K of C's Ball by the Seaside highlighted festivities attended by the Right Reverend Thomas J. Conaty, Bishop of Monterey-Los Angeles, and Supreme Knight Edward L. Hearn. Public transportation to the venue was provided courtesy of the Pacific Gas & Electric Company, utilizing its iconic Red Car trolleys. Los Angeles Knights enjoyed reveling in Playa del Rey so much that they returned to the Del Rey Hotel for their annual banquet and full dress ball in August 1905. The gathering was held to celebrate Embarkation Day, commemorating the anniversary of when Christopher Columbus left port in Palos, Spain, on his first voyage of discovery to the Americas.

The Knights returned to the tranquil shoreline community of PDR less than four years after their initial soirée. Los Angeles Mayor George Alexander showed up in April 1909 to throw out the first pitch at a Young Men's Institute beach baseball game against the Knights of Columbus when they faced one another on a Playa del Rey diamond. Their festive day in the sun and surf included a picnic and track meet; not to mention a voting contest the *Los Angeles Herald* said was used "to decide who (was) the most popular young woman in Southern California, for which a valuable prize (was) offered!"

Many years later, after Council #3744 moved its meeting place from the Westchester Women's Club building on Sepulveda to our current Hall in Playa del Rey, Brother Knights again ran into a Mayor of Los Angeles when they posed for pictures alongside Eric Garcetti who was Grand Marshall of Westchester's 2013 4th of July Parade. Just another one of many times that the Knights of Columbus had fun on LA's Westside.

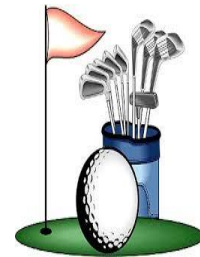

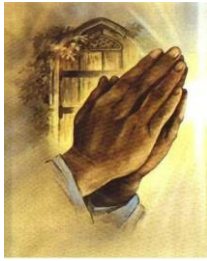
Good News!
