When The Knights Sued a Radical Los Angeles Minister

While some Americans reveled in mass consumerism, jazz-age flappers, and flouting Prohibition laws 100 years ago, others were glued to their radio receivers, listening to fire and brimstone sermons delivered by charismatic ministers. Perhaps the most popular radio preacher during “The Roaring Twenties” was Reverend Robert Pierce “Fighting Bob” Shuler of Los Angeles’ Trinity Methodist Episcopal Church (not to be confused with the Crystal Cathedral’s Rev. Robert Schuller). Shuler objected to divorce, gambling, liquor, and jazz music. He decried the Jewish-run motion picture industry, its movies and actors; and railed against Roman Catholics, especially those who were foreign-born.

Rev. Robert Shuler did not like the Knights of Columbus, especially one of its most prominent members – New York Governor Al Smith, who in 1928 was the Democratic Party’s nominee for President of the United States. In an attempt to harm the politician’s bid for the White House, Shuler published a pamphlet that included an oath purported to have been recited by Smith during his Knights of Columbus 4th Degree exemplification. What he wrote was so offensive that the Knights sued Shuler for criminal libel in 1929.

According to Shuler’s pamphlet titled *Al Smith*, 4th Degree Knights were required to declare, in part: *“I will, when opportunity presents, make and wage relentless war, secretly and openly, against all heretics, Protestants and Masons, as I am directed to do, to extirpate them from the face of the whole earth; and that I will spare neither age, sex or condition, and that I will burn, hang, waste, boil, flay, strangle, and bury alive these infamous heretics; rip up the stomachs and wombs of the women, and crush their infants’ head against the walls, in order to annihilate their execrable race. That when the same cannot be done openly, I will secretly use the poisonous cup, the strangulation cord, the steel of the poinard, or the leaden bullet, regardless of the honor, rank, dignity or authority of the persons, whatever be their condition in life, either public or private, as I at any time may be directed so to do, by any agent of the Pope, or Superior of the Brotherhood of the Holy Father of the Society of Jesus.”*

Failing to do so, Shuler’s publication claimed, Smith and the Knights pledged: *“May my brethren and fellow soldiers of the militia of the Pope, cut off my hands and feet and my throat from ear to ear, my belly opened and sulphur burned therein with all the punishment that can be inflicted upon me on earth and my soul shall be tortured by demons in eternal hell forever.”* Incredible as it may seem today, many of Robert Shuler’s followers believed the oath was genuine. It was, however, later said to have been linked to Crusaders of the Middle Ages. (continued on page #7)

After the oath was declared bogus by investigating bodies, Shuler denied libeling the Knights, claiming freedom of speech, while adding he was only repeating previously available information. Nevertheless, Special Prosecutor David Cannon said of it: "To print a thing and then deny you believe it is sometimes the strongest kind of affirmation." Shuler's libel case went to trial, but when a Los Angeles jury deadlocked 10 to 2 in favor of conviction, a mistrial was declared. After a second trial also failed to return a verdict, the lawsuit was eventually dropped. Such was life for the Knights of Columbus during the Roaring Twenties.

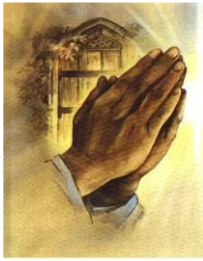

U.S. Army Chaplain Father Emil Kapaun died in a Korean prisoner-of-war camp 72 years ago yesterday. In the decades after the Korean War, Father Kapaun's courage on the battlefield and selfless service to fellow POWs became legendary, leading the U.S. military to recognize him with a Medal of Honor and the Diocese of Wichita, Kansas, to open his cause for canonization. In 2021, the chaplain's remains were finally identified and brought home — with a little help from [Columbia](#) magazine.
